By now your final application packet is in our European Office and they are in the process of carefully selecting your Host Family. This can take up to 90 days but as soon as we receive confirmation of placement you will be notified and can then begin making plans and writing your new European family.

What you must do now is APPLY FOR YOUR PASSPORT. As you may know, you will need a passport to travel to Europe and from country to country within Europe. A valid passport is also required later on when you apply for the "Residence Permit" - mandatory for North American students in Europe. If you have any problems with your passport application, please contact your Area Representative.

Of course you have a thousand questions and we hope to answer these in future information letters. In the meantime, enjoy the excitement and anticipation of becoming an Exchange Student in Europe.
